- Keeping the circle strong with our traditions, songs, dances and languages Aboriginal

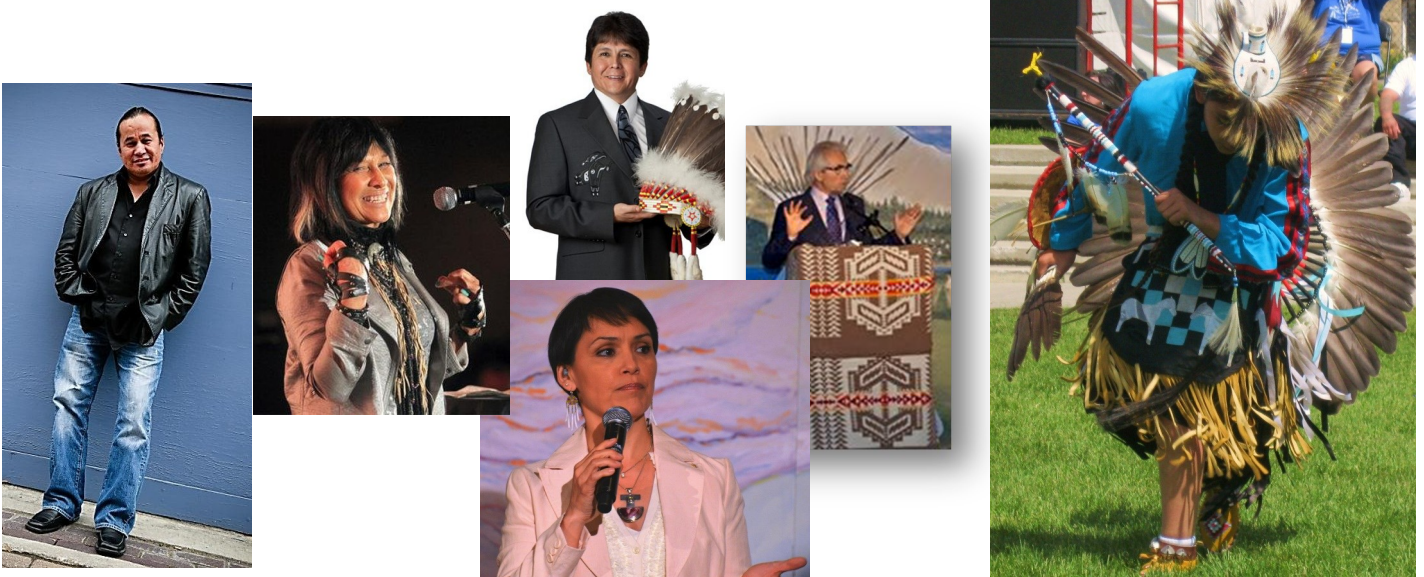
